COMMUNITY RESEARCHER for mapping provision for children and families in Penicuik

An honorarium of £1,000 will be available
for the person to undertake this short-term research.
Some experience of this kind of project is desirable;
but the ability to plan and work diligently
and produce a coherent report is necessary.

The timescale for this is 2 to 3 months
starting as soon as practicable.

We want to recruit a person to help develop a record
of what we know already,
(including schools, social work, and similar agencies,
but also, informal groups, local food pantries, advice
and information services, uniformed organisations,
toddlers' groups and churches).

The aim is to find out, through personal interaction,
what is being done for our target group
(children and families)
and what gaps there are in provision
(and when they occur)
with results presented in a report.
